The ideal combination of passion and technique, the refinement and elegance of the touch, the spiritual and artistic sensitivity, constant, cultural and intellectual commitment to choose an unusual repertory and to enhance its highest contents, the original ideas and the unconventional interpretations are the main features of pianism of Vincenzo Delli Noci.

He started his musical studies with the Maestro Antonio Baldari at the age of 10 years. He graduated with the highest honors in the class of Maestro Adriano Cirillo at the State Musical Conservatory "N.Piccinni" in Bari. Afterward he refined his musical background with Maestro Roberto Cappello.

After winning several piano competitions at national and international level, he has started a brilliant concert career as a soloist in various chamber formations and orchestra with the enthusiastic approval of the public and critics alike.

Delli Noci has recorded a CD with the works of Granados and Albeniz. and a new CD with the most famous waltzes by J. Strauss , transcribed by the greatest piano virtuosos of twentieth century, is about to release .

He has also been a regular guest of the major Italian concert organizations, he has performed in the major European cities such as Zurich, Vienna, Prague and Munich. On March, last year, guest of Iberian & Latin American Music Society, he made his debut in London with a programme completely dedicated to the Spanish music. Among the most recent events, he performed a concert in León (Spain) where he has been invited for the 2012 's cycle of concerts Músicos del Mundo.

Besides the concert activity he works with an exemplary rigour and diligence as regular piano teacher in the State Secondary Schools.
